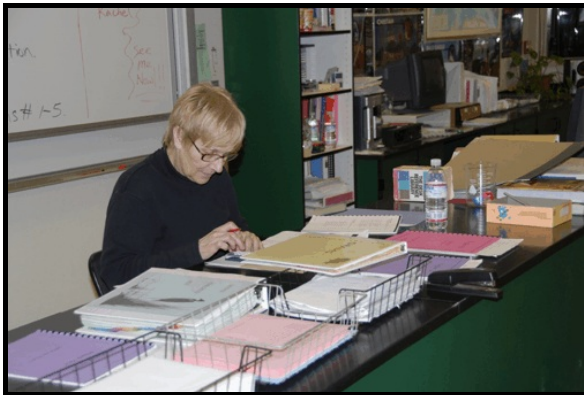


Patterson Adult Education

Patterson Adult Education is an alternative education program provided by the State of California through the Patterson Unified School District. A program is offered for adults to earn a high school diploma granted by the State of California. Students work in an independent study setting supervised by experienced credentialed teachers. Sessions are held Mondays and Wednesdays from 6:30 pm to 9:30 pm on the Patterson High School campus. Classes begin in late August and run through May.

Who is Eligible to Participate in the Program:

To enroll in the program you must:

- be 18 years of age
- not be enrolled in high school.
- be able to provide a copy of your high school transcript
- be able to attend two nights per week

What this Diploma allows You to do:

- Enroll in a California Community College, such as Modesto Junior College.
- Join the military.*
- Satisfy an employer's requirement for a high school diploma.
- Enroll in technical school programs.*

*Depending on the requirements of the branch of the military or educational institution.

General Information:

- No enrollment fee.
- All materials are provided at no cost to student.
- Open enrollment between August and May.
- All previous transferable units will count towards a diploma.
- No time limit to complete the diploma.
- Diploma is issued by State of California, not Patterson Unified School District.
- Re-enrollees are always accepted.
- Available to any California resident, you do not need to live in Patterson.
- GED will be offered (date to be announced)
