

Written & Oral Report on a Scientists

Due: October 18-20

Value: 50 points.

Research information on the scientists you are assigned. Provide a printed copy of your report for the instructor.

The written report must be at *least one full page but no more than 2 pages*, double spaced typed using New Times Roman 12 point font.

The report must include:

- The dates of the life of the scientist
- The country of his/her origin and where he/she did his/her work
- Description of the specific area(s) of study of the scientist
- Summary of the important experiments or observations made by the scientist
- Some information about the life of the scientist – family social status, occupation and any other interesting information about the person
- Summary stating the most important and lasting contribution to world knowledge and how the work of this scientist has affected society today. **This is a very important part of the report.**

Your oral presentation will be either on the 18th or the 20th of October. The reports will be presented in chronological order and will be assigned in alphabetical order of the. I consider this one of the most important assignments of the course and if you miss your oral report date you will receive a "0" on the assignment.
