

Attending Modesto Junior College

As a graduate of the Patterson Unified School District Adult Education program you are eligible to attend California Junior Colleges.

Modesto Junior College is an excellent school and has programs to fit the needs of a wide variety of students. There are many vocational programs available. MJC has an excellent Nursing Program. Students from MJC can transfer to four year colleges such as Cal State University Stanislaus in Turlock.

There are just a few simple steps to follow to register for classes at MJC:

1. Pick up a current **Schedule of Classes**. These are available from Save Mart in the glass fronted case near the water dispenser at south east corner of the store building.
2. Apply for **admissions** in person at the Admissions offices either at the East Campus Student Center or the West Campus Yosemite Hall.

If you **apply by computer** you will need to have a for FAXed to you which you sign and return. You can hand carry it, mail it or FAX it. If you need to FAX it you can have it done at Del Puerto High School or Mr. Field can do it for you. Seen Mr. Field for the number.

3. You will need to arrange for an official copy of your **high school transcript** to be sent to the MJC Records Office, East, East Campus, Morris Memorial Building, Room 105 (209-575-6018)
4. You can apply for **Financial Aid** at the West Campus, Yosemite Hall (209-575-7700)
